

Dear Members and Guests,

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all patrons, I will be implementing a new age policy in stages over the course of the next few months. I would like to ask that all parents/guardians partner with myself and the CYCC staff to instill in our children that the use of the CYCC facility is a privilege, not a right. The Village of Crivitz and the surrounding communities are blessed beyond measure to have had this multi-million dollar facility donated to us by the Nancy Buck Ransom Foundation and we continue to rely on the NBR Foundation for up to 60% of our funding. Teaching our children the respectful treatment of CYCC property, staff, and other patrons will help ensure we continue to receive this support and allow us to appropriate funds to quality youth programs at an affordable price, just as Nancy would have wanted.

For the safety of our youngest patrons, this policy will be effective immediately, and will be enforced as follows:

- **You must check your children in at the CYCC front desk before using the facility.**
- **Children ages 0-11 must have a parent or guardian 16 years or older.**
- **Ages infant through 7 years old:**
 - Direct supervision by a parent or guardian is required at all times in all areas of the facility.
 - They are not permitted to be in the cardio or strength areas of the Wellness Center and they are not permitted to use any type of equipment found in the Wellness Center.
- **Ages 8-11:**
 - May use the entire 1st floor (except the swimming pool) without direct parental/guardian supervision
 - Use of the Wellness Center Track and the CYCC Swimming Pool requires direct parent or guardian supervision
 - They are not permitted to be in the cardio or strength areas of the Wellness Center and they are not permitted to use any type of equipment found in the Wellness Center.
- **CYCC staff reserves the right to redirect your children to behavior that is respectful of CYI property, staff, and other patrons.** This may result in your child being checked into Kid Zone if appropriate or reuniting you with your child.

Nancy loved children and the CYCC facility was created for families to have a fun and affordable place to be together. As a community, we need to take great care to ensure this facility is appreciated and cared for in a manner that allows us to continue to carry on Nancy's legacy of creating safe, affordable, and quality places for children and families to gather and grow together.
